1. **I will leave all electronic listening devices (radios, CD players, mp3 players, iPods, etc.) at home.** If brought these items will be confiscated and kept by the Director until the end of the week. Campers are **not permitted** to make calls home during the week. If there is an emergency, parents will be contacted by the Camp Director. In case of a family emergency, parents may contact the camp office at (800) 636-8452 or (810) 664-7031.
2. Campers will be allowed to bring their cell phones this year to use as cameras, portable Bibles, and note taking devices. Please remember that the SGBA Camp is designed to be a retreat from the world. If the staff believes that the cell phone is being used for other purposes, the camper may lose their privilege to use their cell phones. We highly recommend you consider using the "Airplane Mode" of your device to keep from being tempted to misuse your cell phone.
3. Parents and campers must agree to abide by the following dress code: Shorts must be at least fingertip length. Shirt straps must be at least three fingers in width. No low cut tops. No improper wording or graphics. Pants and shorts will be worn around the waist. Swimsuits must be modest one-piece suits. No Speedos. Please be aware that due to the nature of games and activities, clothes will get dirty.
4. **Registration will begin at 5:00 pm** Sunday, July 20th. Camp closes at 2:00 pm on Friday July 25th and only after camper clean up is completed. **I will arrive no later than 2:00 pm for pickup.**
PARENTS PLEASE NOTE: Campers must stay until the camp has passed clean-up inspection.
5. Campers are expected to stay for the entire camp.
6. All chapels, Bible classes, and activities are to be attended.
7. Smoking, abusive use of drugs, unbecoming talk, dress, bad conduct or leaving the campgrounds will result in dismissal from camp by the director with no refund of fees. Parents/guardian will be responsible for all transportation expenses.
8. We are offering official SGBA Camp shirts this year. If you'd like one, the cost of each shirt is \$6. Sizes will be available on a "first come, first served" basis.

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IMPORTANT INFORMATION - KEEP THIS PAPER FOR YOUR OWN REFERENCE

Cost: \$235 with \$50 deposit and registration before June 15th, \$250 after early registration deadline.

Camper Check-In: Sunday, July 20th, beginning at 5:00 p.m.

Registration Process:

Step 1: Sign-in and pay any remaining balances. Drop off Snack Shack money (We suggest \$20).

Step 2: Medication drop off (Meet the Health Officer) All medications (prescription or over the counter) must be turned in to the health officer upon arrival at camp. All medications must be in their original containers.

Step 3: Get cabin assignment and go drop off your bedding and suitcase in your cabin.

Camper Pick-Up: Camp closes at 2:00 pm on Friday, July 25th. Please arrive no later than 2:00 pm for pickup. Campers must remain until camp has passed inspection. Campers will only be released to persons designated on registration form.

A PHOTO ID is required for those whom we do not know picking up campers! Please check LOST & FOUND at this time.

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS - PLEASE MAKE SURE EVERYTHING IS CLEARLY LABELED!!!

Please use discretion when selecting clothing. What the SGBA considers "modest clothing" should be worn at all times. No improper wording or graphics will be tolerated.

Everyday Wear:

- **GIRLS:** NO short-shorts, slit-shorts, or bikini-cut pants. Shorts should be long enough to reach your finger tips when arms are at the sides. Also NO tube tops, see-through tops, or shirts with "spaghetti straps" Straps must be 3 finger widths. NO low cut tops (no cleavage showing) and top should be covering stomach at all times.
- **BOYS:** NO tank tops or tight shirts and shirts must cover the stomach at all times. NO short shorts or tight shorts. NO baggy pants or shorts, NO underwear is to be showing.

Beach Wear:

- **GIRLS:** Required to wear modest, one-piece swimming suits. A two-piece suit, regardless of the style or cut is NOT allowed. All one-piece suits should be modest (no "French-cut" suits please). Cover-Ups must be worn to and from the swimming area. Girls are asked to bring shorts and T-shirts to be worn during water games.
- **BOYS:** Required to wear boxer style trunks only. No brief style suits are allowed. Boxer style suits should also be modest – no low-riders.

Additional Clothing Info: Kids will participate in outdoor activities. Bring clothes and shoes that you don't mind getting "trashed". Note: If the camp staff thinks that the camper's clothing is not in keeping with the rules, they will be asked to change their clothing OR we will have them wear clothing that we will provide for them and they PROBABLY WON'T LIKE IT! :)

WHAT TO BRING:

- Fan (there's no air conditioning in the cabins)
- Bathing Suit and Cover Up (see above)
- Sleeping Bag or Bedding, Pillow

- Insect Repellent
- Sunscreen
- Flashlight
- Disposable Camera (with name on it)
- Baseball Glove
- Dirty Clothes Bag
- Water Bottle

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

We prohibit campers from bringing computers, CD players, iPods, mp3 players, electronic games, radios, etc. No alcohol, tobacco products, weapons, firearms, and fireworks.

If these items are brought to camp, they will be confiscated and returned to the campers at pick-up. The staff of the SGBA camp will do its best to keep confiscated items secured but will not be held responsible if these items are lost or stolen while under our care, so please don't bring them!
